Eligibility Requirements

- 1) You must be a high school graduate or have a general equivalency diploma (GED)
- 2) Must be currently enrolled. You cannot be enrolled in another school offering a similar course of study at the time of awarding or distributing.
- 3) Current student applications must maintain 90% grades and 90% attendance. The Admissions office will verify this information.

Scholarship details

- 1) All applications will be reviewed by the advisory board; all decisions are final.
- 2) Applications should be submitted to Adrianna Powers in the admissions office. (apowers@summitsalonacademy.com)
- 3) A scholarship in the amount of \$1,500 will be awarded and applied towards tuition needed to complete the student's training.



- 4) Winners will be notified by **October 31, 2017**.
- 5) Applicant will complete two essays
- 6) Essay judging criteria are based on:

 - Dedication to the salon professional industry
 - Articulation of thought in the allotted amount of words
- 7) Application must provide a letter of recommendation from someone outside of family who is qualified to offer testimony of your character.
